Eventually went to Brighton in 1918 where it was added to a home for the family of Mr Marks, the Superintendent of the Pullman Car Company, with sister coach Dunrobin .

A 1914 seven-compartment side-corridor third built by Birmingham Railway Carriage and Wagon for the Glasgow and South Western Railway is preserved by the Scottish Railway Preservation Society at Falkirk.

A number of these coaches were preserved by the Bluebell Railway. In 1962, Stepney came on loan to Sodor bringing his controller and a rake of coaches from the Bluebell Railway. These passenger coaches were originally owned by the Metropolitan Railway.

The other coach, numbered E1729E, went into a long period of storage at Steamtown, Carnforth. Both coaches survive today in the hands of Railway Vehicle Preservations Ltd on the preserved Great Central Railway, Loughborough, where they allow first class ticket holders to travel in restored E1719E.
